# Meeting Minutes

## Activity Reports:

### *Stock:*

Kyle Bahl reported that he'll be placing a bid for 2014 Nationals at the APBA national meeting. Kyle added that he expects a lot of discussion on class consolidation, and asked members with agenda items to get those to him or to Dave Anderson. Dave added that he's working out a proposal for a new spec class with a claimer option.

### *Mod:*

J-Dub Myers asked members to send agenda items to him, and noted his focus is on bringing the Tohatsu motor to full acceptance in the Category.

### *PRO:*

Dwight Malhiot repeated the advice to get potential agenda items to him or to George Thornhill.

### *J-Classes:*

Pat Gleason echoed the call to send in agenda item proposals, noting that those in written form are best.

## Old Business:

### *Inboard Lawrence date shift:*

Jim Nilsen reported that Inboard Lawrence lake has been moved a week ahead on the schedule to April 9th & 10th, the weekend following our spring Eatonville race.

### *Winternationals & more:*

Jim followed news of the Lawrence schedule shift with a rundown of other important west coast dates. he noted Stock Winternationals (including AX) set for Indio, CA on March 5th and 6th. He said Cullaby Lake will host Western Divisionals for Stock and J-classes and might include Nationals for 45. Kyle Bahl explained the 45 Nationals move was due to Wakefield

passing on 45s (Water and diver issues reported) and hinged on pending APBA approval. Cullaby was thought a good fit due to its central location and because it fell out of conflict with California OPC events.

Jim went on to Note that PRO Western Divisionals will take place at Moses Lake, and Mod Western Divisionals tentatively scheduled for our second Eatonville regatta, scheduled July 8th through 10th.

### *J-Project:*

Jim asked members with free Saturday time to drop by the hydro museum. Two J-Hydros remain uncompleted as well as a third donated to the club that needs to be completed for use in displays and in the "New folks in boats" program. Completing those boats will bring two new racers in and open space for the next group of family builders. We're also looking for families interested in joining the build program. ### *SOA Racing Calendar:*

Pat Gleason reported that all calendar pages have been sold and pictures are being sent in. The calendar will be laid out March 2011 through February to March to match our racing year, and will have all our race-dates noted. He expects to get it print-available just after the first of the year so it can be available for purchase starting mid-January. Proceeds will go toward funding Mossyrock.

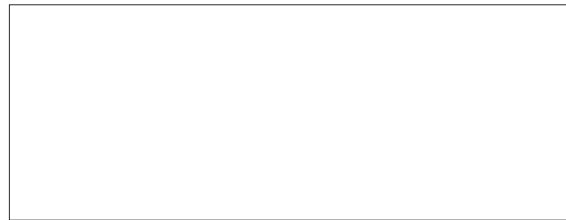

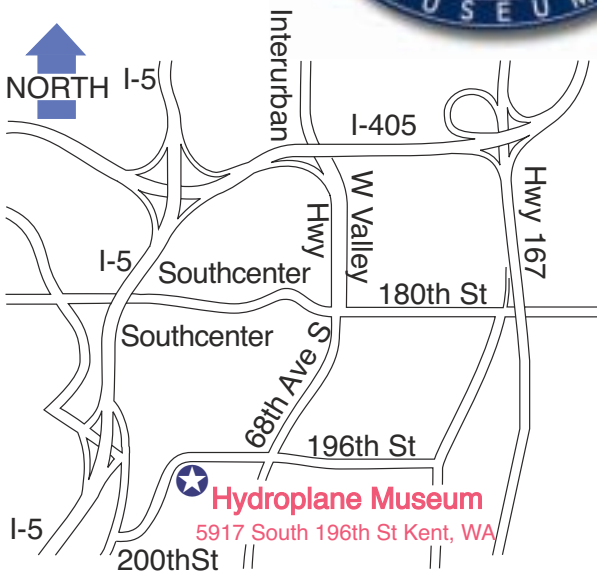
