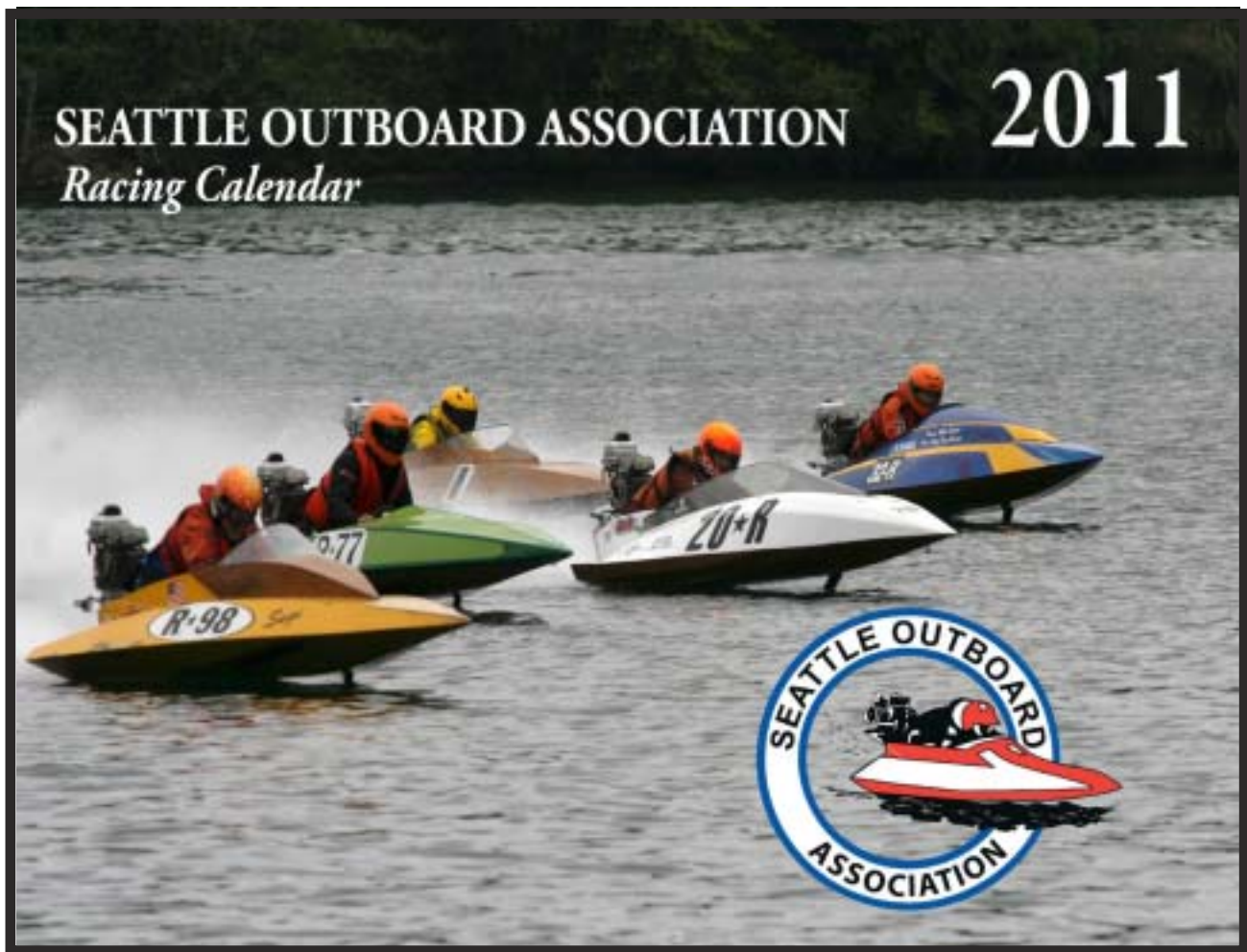

# Meeting Minutes

22  
February  
2011

## Activity Reports:

### Stock:

Dave Anderson and Rocky Peterson told members that the national meeting was mostly uneventful but noted ongoing tests to certify performance for the sidewinder 15 motor. Dave described a developing Novice-C class, suggesting it might get a trial at Mossyrock, and noted an upcoming parity meeting to set prop height for D-Stock.

Jan Shaw briefly explained scoring changes noting those changes do not apply to Outboards.

Kyle Bahl announced to members that SOA has been selected to present APBA's Stock/Mod National Championship for 2014. Kyle also noted that APBA Winternationals has been shifted to SOA's Eatonville regatta following site-acquisition difficulty at the chosen Region 12 location.

Finally, Kyle told members that SOA will establish a Live-Stream project funded by SORC.

### Mod:

J.W. Myers reported that Mod rejected the Tohatsu D-motor once again.

### PRO:

Dwight Malhiot described a variety of minor rules changes made at the National Meeting that included a ballot item. Dwight also reported that the PRO Commission voted to extend contributing to ambulance costs for new driver programs.

### J/AX:

Pat Gleason reported no major changes in the category, though there is work underway to bring parity to the Mercury/OMC motors.

### Safety Equipment:

Patrick spoke on helmet and safety gear regulation, describing discussions on jacket and cut-suit certification and firm decisions on helmets such as that banning helmets that are certified by DOT alone.

### APBA Operations:

Pat Gleason told members of a plan presented that would revise the way APBA handles day to day business. Under the plan much of the routine business and records keeping would be automated and funds invested to enhance APBA's website.

Jim Nilsen read through a list of this season's regattas Here regatta dates with added importance:

Eatonville, April 1st thru 3rd has been upgraded to Winternationals. It's a three day event with Friday testing on a records course. drivers meeting is set for 8:30 with racing beginning at 10 a.m. We expect a lot of boats.

Cullaby Lake, June 24th/25th, will be western Stock and J Divisionals, and 45ss Nationals.

Eatonville-2 July 8/9/10 will devote friday to novice rides and will host Mod Divisionals

Moses Lake September 10/11 will run PRO Divisionals

April & July Eatonville regattas, Newberg, Cullaby Lake and Fall Lawrence Lake, with Mossyrock as a back-up/tie-breaker.

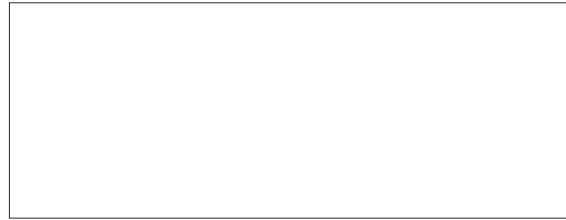
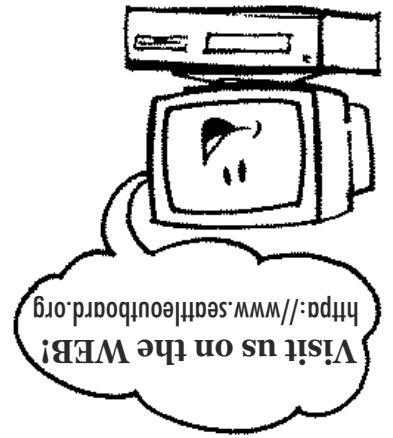

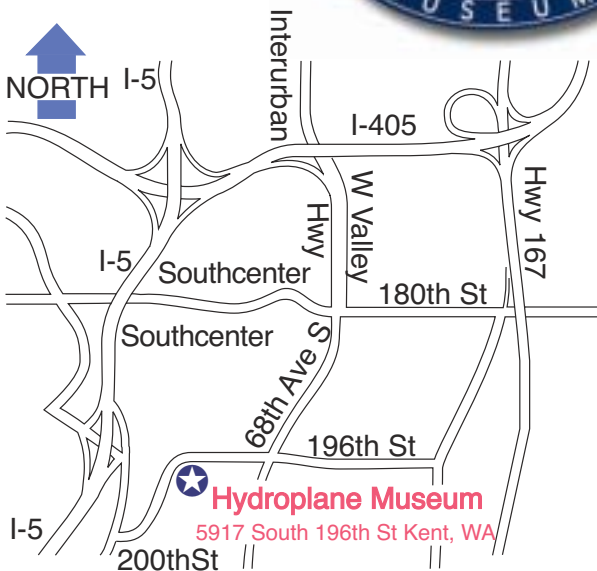
