## Check Your Jetting for Moses Lake Nationals

Conditions at Moses Lake differ from the coast. Elevation is 1200 ft but hotter temperatures there make the effective elevation between 3000 to 4000 ft. @ 80 to 100 degrees F In aviation they call this the Density Altitude because heat makes air less dense. 100¼ F there is equivalent to running your engine at 4000 ft on a cool day. The oxygen in the air goes down 3% per every 1000 ft so there will be 12% less Oxygen for your engine at 100¼ at Moses Lake. This means a fuel jet setting that works in Seattle will be too rich at Moses and power will be down. Install smaller jets to lean the engine, starting with jets of 5% less area and working down to 10% less area.. Even when your engine is perfectly tuned and jetted though, power will be down 9-12% due to less oxygen in the air. The net effect is that you will not be able to pull the same props you use at Lawrence Lake. Density Altitude is the reason and most of us never bothered to rejet for Moses Lake or Scootney. But Nationals are on-deck and we want to do well so take your jets with you and do some testing under Moses Lake conditions. Good Luck.

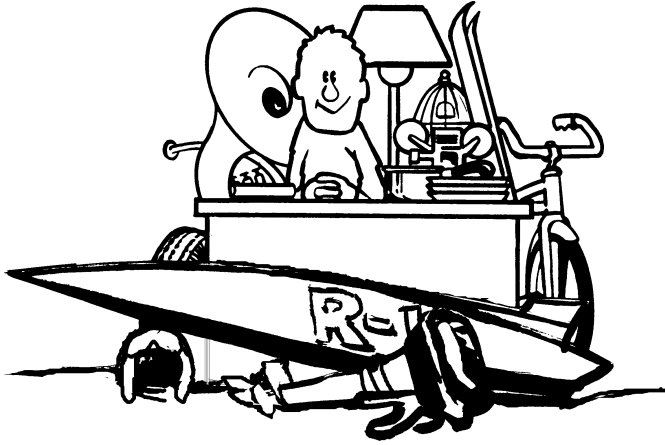

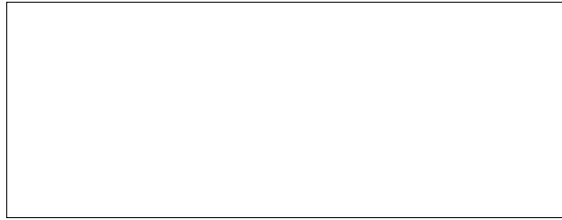
