Meeting Minutes

23 August, 2005

Activity Reports:

Stock:

Dave Anderson noted a meeting regarding fuel and inspectors' powers to DQ. Tony Perman asked about production of new OMC gearcases. Dave guessed about ten. Jimi Oberto offered clarification on the 20ss oversize pistons.

Old Business:

Scooteny:

Jim Nilsen reported good weather, but wind on Sunday cut the program back. Jim said entry numbers were good and the event was helped along by sponsorship from the antique classes

Jim also noted 4 crashes each day and a serious problem with civilian power-boaters intruding on the course. Other problems included a same-day scheduled bass tournament, and troubles keeping Hispanic locals' kids out of the restricted waters.

Nationals:

Steve Greaves reported that PRO nationals were a success for SOA racers. He noted good weather and about 230 entries. He added that in addition to the PRO classes, nationals also featured the UIM O175 Worlds, which was won by Tim Small. Steve listed the exploits of SOA racers at DePue (*noted elsewhere*).

Todd Cragin told members that there were 5 Region 10 entries at

Stock Nationals, and described the event and results.

New Business:

Eatonville:

Tony Perman reported that everything was in place and going well thanks to Oberto sponsorship and he announced that the 3/4 mile records course will be back on Silver Lake next year under the auspices of Oberto.

There was talk of the powder-puff event over needs by competitors for things like equipment, kevlar and other safety gear.

Lawrence Lake:

Jan Shaw reported the circular was out, and pointed out that there will be an additional fee for those who elect not to pre-register. She added that the course size is likely to be set at 1-1/4 miles.

Moses Lake:

Ryan Johnson said that sheriff's approval has been given, and noted the schedule is set to include Marathons for stock runabouts, a powder-puff and an "Apple-Cup" between UW and WSU racers.

Museum Project:

Craig Fjarlie detailed the Hydro Museum's plans to build four J-Class kit boats starting October. They hope to get help from SOA members, and are looking for motors and equipment to have four completed boats with drivers on the water for the 2006 season.

Membership Roster:

Craig Fjarlie talked about production of the new roster, and noted that we need to include E-Mail addresses and Cell numbers because they have become common contact methods.

Warden Lake:

Howard Shaw reported on a lake he surveyed that might stand as a replacement for Scooteny. The lake is located in the Moses Lake/Othello area. Howard describes the site as similar to Scooteny, with enough length for kilo trials. The lake is privately owned, with the owner looking to refurbish the resort and sell home sites. The lake is sheltered and free of bass boats and Jet-skis.

2007 Nationals:

Dave Anderson reported on committee set-ups, and said a meeting will be held in September, and said he would attend the September NBRA race.

Officer Nominations:

Craig Fjarlie reminded members that nominations for club officers, plus nominations for SOA Service and Sportsmanship awards are to be taken at the September 27th meeting.

Other:

Region Banquet:

The date for the meeting and banquet has been shifted to November 26 at the Little Creek Casino. Because of the later date, Region ballots must be mailed in.

This year's Chuck Hickling Memorial Regatta at Henley's Silver Lake Resort was one big party. There was the usual great racing, and after hours fun, but with some interesting additions and twists to add a little flavor.

Racing was enhanced Saturday by SOA's first Powder-Puff race in about

umpty-five years. Racers scabbled together enough kevlar, helmets, jackets and 20ss Hydros to put twenty-seven ladies on the lake for a series of eliminations that led to victory by Rebecca Nilsen (at left).

Other Racerettes who stood out were Kim Bartlett who ran fast and looked competent saying the boat did it, and Joanne Heggeman who did a pretty good impression of a comet in her one heat, but the boat was unable to come out for the next heat.

Saturday night Pat Gleason presented Turf Boat racing to the crowd. This is basically a much bigger version of the old "roostertail" board game, with bigger and much better playing pieces. A large oval course was set up on the lawn in front of the resort cabins using pyramid buoys with nails embedded to anchor them to the lawn, and players chose their boats. The Boats (Playing pieces) are solid wood 4 inch Unlim-

ited Hydros, detailed in team colors and design. To play, you roll 4 "X4" dice. You have a choice of 2. One has various numbers up to 10 denoting how many buoys you travel around the course. The other is a "nitrous" die, and it offers a 16, but all the other sides are disasters, DNFs, a zero and a flip.

The crowd got into the game's spirit early when Kyle Lewis picked the Elam as his boat. Every time Kyle rolled the dice the crowd booed, and on Kyle's first roll, when he only managed a 5, somebody shouted "YOU'RE FIRED!"

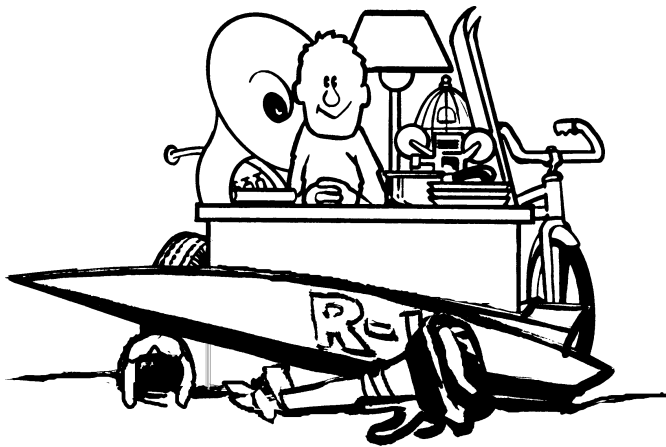
