

## Scorers Report



### Scoring Update: Trackside is coming to SOA

I'm excited to share that Trackside is coming to an SOA race as part of an upcoming testing program. While we don't yet know which event it will be, Seattle Outboard will be among the clubs helping introduce this new system once final configuration is complete.

Trackside is a new registration and race management platform being developed by American Power Boat Association to modernize how registration, scoring, and race-day data are handled. Once implemented, race registration for the test event will be run through Trackside, giving racers and officials an early look at what's coming next.

From a scoring perspective, this is an exciting step forward aimed at reducing manual processes, improving accuracy, and making race days smoother for everyone involved. As with any new system, there will be a learning curve, and that's exactly what these test events are for. Our scoring team is preparing, and I appreciate everyone's patience as we work through something new together.

In the meantime, members can and should register now for their APBA membership, which will be required for Trackside registration. If you need help or have questions, please reach out to Kelsie, Jan, or Denise...we're happy to help!

More details will be shared as soon as an event is selected and registration information is finalized. We're proud to be part of this effort and excited to help shape the future of race operations in Region 10.

## APBA Junior Racing Committee

### Notes from the 2026 APBA National Meeting

#### **Equipment**

13 complete four stroke motors in stock and available from APBA at a cost of \$2600 plus shipping. 6 Mercury short blocks are on the shelf, zero complete 2 stroke motors and zero OMX / J / AX gearcases available.

New OMC gearcase are being produced by APBA with an updated water pump and are expected to be for sale late in 2026 at a target price of \$1995.

John Korbus and Brown Tool Machine have both designed 4 stroke steering bars, throttle cable brackets and kill switch assemblies for the 4 stroke J engine.

#### **Rule Changes**

Four stroke minimum weight will be 345lbs. AX height moved to 1.75" to help control the speed of the class. Four stroke engines will run an APBA standard prop with the sharp tips removed.
